

Jackson Elementary's Beliefs


Everyone is capable of learning.




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2015 - 2017 Comparison - CCRPI





Percent of students' assessments scoring at Proficient or Distinguished Learner on the GMAS










% of Students with SGPs meeting Typical/High Growth in ELA

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


% of Students with SGPs meeting Typical/High Growth in Math



% of Students with SGPs meeting Typical/High Growth in Science






% of Students with SGPs meeting Typical/High Growth in Social Studies





Achievement Gap - 2017






