Instructional Plan

Increase Content Mastery in ELA and Math

- Set growth goals based on the MAP Assessment.
- Provide support to students based on the MAP assessment, (ESOL, EIP, SWD, Gifted).
- Have a structured MTSS for academics and behavior.
- Have a structured formative assessment plan which will allow teachers to assess standards weekly, and to inform small group instruction.
- Provide professional development to faculty and staff members based on assessment results and TKES observations.
- Academic Coach will provide side-by-side coaching and model instruction based on instructional needs for teachers.
- Administration and Academic Coach will lead grade-level collaborative planning sessions where student work samples are assessed, common assessments created if necessary, and teachers collaborate when planning.

Progress

- Analyze Access scores from the prior year to determine whether students have improved within a performance band or if they moved up to another performance band.
- Monitor ESOL instruction closely through formal and informal observations
- Provide professional development to support student growth and achievement of ESOL students to all teachers

Closing Gaps

- Determine improvement targets in ELA and Math
- Target Subgroups to make progress or meet improvement targets in each subject area
- Monitor subgroup performance on MAP Assessments and other formative assessments throughout the year
- Utilize personalized instruction to meet the varying needs of students
